Since the fall of the Iron Curtain and Czechoslovakia's own Velvet Revolution, the 'City of a Thousand Spires' has rightly attracted visitors in droves, drawn to its beguiling architecture, world-class beer and vibrant nightlife. It is quite simply one of the most stunning cities in Europe, a UNESCO World Heritage-listed gem that has become the archetypal post-communist city success story. Not a month goes by, it seems, without someone finding the next 'New Prague'. Few first-time visitors leave having not seen Prague Castle, but there's plenty more to the city than the grand old hilltop retreat. Both the Malá Strana and Staré Město quarters are rich in historic appeal, lined with churches, palaces and other glorious relics, and more galleries than any art fan could hope for – but wherever you are in the Czech capital, catch the perfect snap with your new Casio and you can always superimpose yourself in later on with its 'dynamic photo function'. Whether easing under Charles Bridge on a rowing boat on a balmy summer evening, or trudging across the crisp snow of the Old Town Square and enjoying a glass of mulled wine at the Christmas Market, this slick, but still deeply characterful Czech capital seldom disappoints.

SECRET HIDEAWAYS

Restaurant on the hill Views are plentiful in Prague, but the best is from this ideal little eatery halfway up the Petrin Hill funicular. With tables looking down over the spires and domes of the capital, have a sunset dinner for just £20, including beer and wine, before heading back for a stroll home along the cobbles (nebozizek.cz)

The Lanterna Magika In a city where irony and theatre appear hardwired into its genetic makeup, the theatre where Václav Havel plotted the 1989 revolution inefably captures the spirit of Prague through ingenious performances combining mime, film, theatre, dance, and light (laterna.cz)

HOW TO GET BETTER COMPOSITIONS

- Move the subject slightly off-centre to vary your pictures and create different balances.
- Keep the background simple with no distracting elements so the main image stands out.
- If the subject you're shooting is taller than it is wide, turn your camera 90 degrees to maximize the area of the subject in your camera viewfinder.

The Helmut Newton Foundation and Museum If you're interested in photography or the specific work of a legendary fashion snapper, this is a must.
