Open the lens cover on the back of the N95 and you activate the camera. All five megapixels of it. The buttons you need to take a picture glow blue, so you know what you're doing straight away (and, crucially, so does the photographer when you're in frame...) Video at DVD-quality 30fps, but without the shake - there's some great autostabilisation at work here. And because the Nokia N95 has that fast internet, you can email your pics and clips, or put them online there and then. Point and shoot, then send or save: the good times remembered and shared. Properly.

You can have the world in your pocket. The N95 is a full-on portable GPS unit. Maps, routes, ways in and ways out for most of the known world. Of course, if you don't want anyone to know where you're going, the Nokia N95's GPS will help you get suitably lost, too. All told, it's a very moving experience.

It works both ways with the Nokia N95. Slide the front up, you reveal the keyboard. Slide it down, and you have the music controls, backlit in blue. It's quicker off the blocks than most standalone digital music players, and more friendly with the file formats. Watching videos is equally pleasing - that 2.6" screen again - and you can do it either portrait or landscape, depending on what you want. The quality is way beyond what you're used to on kit like this. Another bonus? The speaker jack's 3.5mm - the standard size - so you can use your good headphones.
